Good Quantum Number

Classical Theory 1 Free Space: Translational symmetry >> Conservation of momentum law

Classical Theory 2 Planetary Systems Rotational symmetry >> Conservation of angular momentum (Kepler's law, constant angular velocity)

Quantum theory for atoms: Rotational symmetry >> Conservation of angular momentum Angular momentum is a good quantum number in the system >>1s 2s 2p.....

Crystal lattice: Translational symmetry with respect to lattice >> Conservation of crystal momentum >> Crystal momentum, or wavenumber, is a good quantum number of the system >> band dispersion

Vacuum level at where?

The vacuum level refers to the energy of a free stationary electron that is outside of any material (it is in a perfect vacuum). It may be taken as infinitely far away from a solid, or, defined to be near a surface.

•Where is the place of rest electron just outside solid.

P-type and n-typ of semiconductor

- P or N should be defined on the basis of the type of majority carrier
- In inorganic semiconductors, P or N is determined on the basis of dopant.
- In organic semiconductors, p or n seems to be dependent on molecule (?)

P and **N** in Organic Semiconductors

- 無機半導体における p 型、 うかは確立されていない。 n型発現の機構が有機半導体にも適用できるかど
 - 有機における p 、 n の判定
 - 多数キャリアの直接的な同定は一般に容易ではない。
 - 何らかの電気特性を使ってp、nを判定することが多い。
 - 光起電力が、高仕事関数電極との接合で生じればn型、低仕事関数だとp型など
 - ギャップ内でのフェルミ準位の位置など
 - 有機半導体は本来は真性半導体のはずだが、「意図しないドーピング」が生じている
 - p型は大気中の酸素がアクセプターとして作用していると信じられている
 - n型は謎. 正体不明のドナーが作用しているという説もある。
 - キャリアの発生機構が、無機半導体と有機半導体では違う可能性がある。有機材料が持つイオン化ポテンシャルや電子親和力の違いによって、キャリアの注入されやすさが電子または正孔のどちらかに偏る?

P-type organic semiconductors: Majority carrier is hole and/or hole can be easily injected. N-type organic semiconductors: Majority carrier is hole and/or hole can be easily injected.

p,n control of organic semiconductors by substitution

- *n*: carrier density
- μ: mobility

Band transport and Hopping transport

Usually, positive / negative carriers are cation radical/ anion radical in the case of organic. In the case of inorganic semiconductor, electron and hole. In the case of organic crystal, the situation may be intermediate.



Quasi Fermi Level (imref)

We can define a quasi Fermi level and quasi temperature due to thermal equilibrium of electrons in conduction band, and quasi Fermi level and quasi temperature for the valence band similarly.
